Trash Pick-up

Service Provider:

- Waste Management Company

Policy:

- Trash and articles for recycling are picked up each week; the charge for this service is included in the Homeowner's monthly dues.

Procedure:

- Trash and recycle carts need to be stored inside the garage within 24 hours before and after pick-up. Overland Park ordinance provides penalties for violation of this rule.
- Place your trash and recycle carts at curbside by 7 AM each **Friday**. (Days will be pushed back one day should a holiday occur during the week)
- For Owners of six-plexes, place your receptacles by your garage door(s).
- All trash should be placed in bags inside your carts.
- Arrows on the carts are to point toward the street for easy access by the hauler.
- Yard waste (leaves and grass clippings) are to be placed in large paper bags (can be purchased at hardware stores). There is a limit of six (6) bags per pick up.
- Small limbs should be cut into four (4) foot lengths, tied into bundles less than 18 inches in diameter, and weighing no more than 50 pounds each. (These bundles are included in the six bag limit.)
- Stickers can be purchased (usually at a local hardware store) for extra bags of household trash if needed.
- Large Item pick-up is scheduled on the **first Friday** of the month. Large items are limited to one item per month, should be no longer than five (5) feet, and weigh no more than fifty (50) pounds.
- Loose household items or large items will not be picked up on regular pick-up days. Call the trash service company to arrange for this service. The Homeowner will be charged separately for this special pickup.
